## About Southern Districts Car Club

The Southern Districts Club has been established since 1966 in a variety of motor sport disciplines. We welcome all walks of life, and promote and encourage activities between club members while fostering courtesy and friendship on the public roads.

The club is open to all age groups and car makes, with competition starting at 12yrs of age for Motorkhanas and 14yrs for Khanacross. It does not matter if you are a beginner or a National Champion.

SDCC promote and run a variety of events, ranging from Motorkhanas (arguably the cheapest form of motor sport) to Khanacross, Autocross, Hillclimbs, Rallysprints and Rallies. We also have a range of social events thought the year that are advertised in our monthly magazine.

SDCC offers training in navigation, event command, scrutineering, general official duties and driver control, providing the opportunity to experience vehicle control in a safe environment.

### OFFICIALS

Acting as an official is a great way to get to know people and build lasting friendships within the club. It often allows you to get the best view of all the action, and is also a great way to learn what areas of motorsport you are interested in before you begin competing.

### Motorkhana

A motorkhana is a test of braking, manoeuvrability, and driver control through a series of tests. Competition is on either dirt or a sealed surface. The cost is about \$20 for a day where you may get up to 12 runs. This is a great way to develop and enhance car control skills while having plenty of fun. We hold dirt events at a property in Mt Compass and also at Monarto for a sealed surface. Both road registered and unregistered cars can compete.

### Khanacross



A Khanacross involves car control around a permanent circuit, with a slalom of cones to keep the speed down along the straights. It provides a higher speed element, still against a stopwatch. We hold these at Lanac Park (near Mt Compass) and road cars are welcome. The cost for a day is about \$40. SDCC welcomes new members, and spectators are free to come and enjoy one of the fastest growing, cheaper motor sport events available.



The Southern Districts Car Club CAMS Junior Development Program is aimed at enabling new drivers (regardless of skill level) to participate in activities in a well organised, highly disciplined and controlled environment. CAMS in conjunction with the Southern Districts Car Club have enabled this project to happen.

CAMS believe that assisting young drivers to develop skills in car control and responsible vehicle management, prior to official civil driving licence minimum age, makes them better and safer road users.

Juniors who display adequate skills to compete in a motorkhana or khanacross (depending on age, motorkhana 12+ and khanacross 14+) will be given the opportunity to use the Southern Districts Car Club cars for a small fee at SDCC events. If SDCC cars are used in competitive events, an experienced SDCC driver will be made available to sit in the passenger seat as an instructor.

### Registration

The cost to register for the SDCC Junior Development Program is \$190.00 per child. The registration cost includes 4 JDP days, a year's junior membership to SDCC, a CAMS level 2NSJ licence for one year, and a SDCC CAMS Junior Development cap. If a family wish to join SDCC, membership is \$70.00 per year.

### 2011 Junior Development Program

There are four CAMS JDP days in 2011 covered by your registration fee to cover fuel, tyres, track lease and general maintenance of the cars and helmets through the year. The dates are March 12, April 30, July 16, and August 27. SDCC can supply helmets as well as the cars for use on all Junior Development days (own cars can be used by arrangement).

## Autocross

Also held at Lanac Park, with a traffic light starting system, no slalom or lane changes, and a flying finish. This is a real speed event on a registered Autocross track. The 2011 calendar includes the SA Autocross Championship, Round 1 of the SA Clubman Series.



## Hillclimb

**Mt Alma Mile Hillclimb**, run entirely on a closed section of road with a bitumen surface. The climb up the hill is very steep, with a rise of around 180m from start to finish. In its 3<sup>rd</sup> year, it has become a premier event, attracting competitors in all types of cars from around Australia!

## Rally

The **Adelaide Hills Tarmac Rally** is one of the highlights of the SDCC calendar. Run on some of the best Adelaide Hills Tarmac Roads, it has earned a place in SA Rally Championship, but also the Australian Tarmac Rally Championship. Entries include performance vehicles like Lamborghinis and Ferraris through to the classic Datsuns and Escorts. In 2011 the AHTR will go to air on Network 10 and ONE HD channels.

The **Kuitpo Forest Rally** is run over a course of dirt roads and forest trails, it has become a competitor favourite. With the event having Over a decade of history it has become a well known event with, entries include turbo-charged 4wd's, V8's, and the ever popular Datsuns and Escorts. This event is Round 4 of the SA Rally Championship and Round 3 of the SA Clubman Series.
