The Planning for Day 4 of the JDP start very early in the year as Shawn Graz from CAMS had spoken at the SA state council and with a referral from Michael Clements that this was something that required further investigation on how we could integrate it into the SDCC CAMS JDP.

After many conversations and emails Shawn had the program "Illicit Drugs in Sports ready to roll out to present to youth.

I would like to thank the Southern Districts Car Club for their support as they suggested and approved the offer of flights for Shawn to present the program to Our JDP Students. This showed CAMS that we as a club invest into the future of our JDP Students and wish to provide a quality program with a professional approach and the type of program that Southern Districts Car Club and the Confederation of Australian Motorsport can be very proud of. With Shawn's help I suggested that we approach SAMROA CAMS JDP suggesting that the opportunity to share Shawn's visit to South Australia and for him to speak at their program at no cost to them as Southern Districts would be paying for the flight cost.

SDCC wrote to the Minister for Motorsport in South Australia Mr. Kevin Foley. As Day 4 was in the planning stage I had hoped to have a special guest to present the certificates to the students that completed the 2011 Junior Development Program. It was unfortunate that Mr. Foley was unable to attend. (I had to ring his office to find out they were unable to accept our invitation). I wrote to Isobel Redmond and was pleased to receive a reply from her. She commended the club on the program and felt that it is an excellent approach for young drivers to develop the skills which prepares them for driving, as well as building on their personal development in areas of confidence, teamwork and leadership. Mr. Steven Griffiths would be attending to represent her. Steven and his wife Donna attended and presented certificates and key rings to the Students. He also viewed our track and facilities at Lanac Park. We since have received a letter and a personal donation from Steven and His wife to put towards next year program.

Students had an early start to the day as it was a very busy schedule. The Shed at Lanac was converted to a make shift class room with seating and screen for the projector was erected. The shed is powered by generator as the track is in the middle of a paddock at Lanac Park, Mt Compass. Shawn's presentation was made up of short presentations of situations students could find themselves in. Each Presentation was discussed and students participated in answering questions and general discussion. I don't think it had anything to do with standing with a hand full of chocolate bars. Chocolate bars flying round the room made for a very serious topic to be enjoyed by all and he had the total room's attention, even all the parents. The Students were given a backpack with hat, drink bottle, sunscreen, towel, lip balm and vital information sheet about drugs and the effects.

I had chosen 10 students from previous years SDCC CAMS JDP's to attend. These students were still participating in motorsport at National, State and Multi club and Club level. Some of whom had attended this year's Program to assist with presentations to the students on day 1 and day 2.

## Chris Simmons Had an Eventful Rally Oz with Guy

Wow what an event! We left for Coffs Harbour on the Sunday morning before the event at 4am, meeting up with the Busby crew at Gawler and then traveled to 50km past Cobar and stopped for the night. On Monday we made into Coffs at around 6:30PM. The views coming down the range into Coffs were amazing.

We met our navigator [Jenna Kelly](#) for the first time in person that night. The crews of Mike Busby-Chris Edmonson, Guy and Jenna then went to do documentation and were back in 30 minutes! Not bad when you consider that the doco location was 10 minutes drive away!

The next day I got a UVP so we could run the car on public roads in NSW. The people at the RTA were very helpful and a permit for the four days of the rally was only \$21.00. Taking the rego back to doco was just as painless taking less than 5 minutes to get the go ahead to proceed.

We also needed to fix the mounting of the fire bomb so Stewart and I went to the local Bunnings to find some hardware to redo the mounting. Just as we were about to turn into Bunnings we spotted a full size replica of Mack from the "Cars" animated movie, all thoughts of work ceased and cameras were hurriedly found. With all of the prep work and fitting of the GPS tracker required for a WRC event Stewart and I worked for 14 hours on Tuesday and 16 hours on Wednesday, just finishing before having to take the Evo to scrutineering. This was also done very efficiently and apart from having to replace the hand held fire extinguishers (as the current ones were out of date) we breezed through in about 20 minutes.

Thursday we managed a sleep in (7am). Jenna needed the seat moved up about 50mm but I had to wait for my wife Sandie and the kids to arrive as they had the new seat mounts in their luggage. With the seat moved up and the foot rest moved backward 50mm the crew were ready to go racing that night at the super special stage around the Coffs Harbour jetty precinct.

The SSS didn't go quite to plan as the Evo was under steering into corners and resulted in a hit on an Armco barrier which bent the left steering arm. Service the next morning (Friday) was only 15 minutes and we had to straighten the steering arm and do a rough wheel alignment in that time. We had the crew back in the car in 9 minutes!

An off in the carnage ridden Shipman's stage saw the crew lose 25 minutes before being able to continue to the remote refuel. Guy and Jenna said that about every 4th-5th corner there was a car off in the bush on that stage and with the World champion and runner up from last year crashing on that stage, just getting through was an achievement for any of the crews. Overnight rain in the hills above Coffs had turned the roads into a sloppy mess and the further down the starting order you were the worse it was. Another off in the afternoon bent the steering again but with no service before the SSS the crew had to put up with it. With a 45 minute service that night I started to straighten the steering rod again but as I was doing it I discovered a crack in the rod and it would have to be replaced. Guy and I had done the right hand one two weeks before, and on a hoist it had taken us 4 and a half hours. The left side had much more clearance behind the engine to get the rack end nut undone. The steering rod was replaced in 35 minutes and we did a wheel alignment in the morning service to make the car drivable once again. Another two offs on Saturday saw the Evo looking very second hand with tape and cable ties holding the front bumper and headlights on. We finished the event without missing a stage and even though we were the last of the finishers at least we finished!

I would like to thank the following people for their incredible efforts before during and after the event. James and the guys from Coffs Harbour Motorwell who supplied us with a car to use as a reccie vehicle and a runaround while we were there, sorry about the windscreen! (Guy and Jenna were on their way to reccie the first stage when a rock was flung up from a truck tyre). Aluminum Dynamics for the awesome seat brackets. B&R Autogas and exhaust for the use of their workshop to prepare the car. Walkers Creative art for the sign writing. S2 Performance for the suspension set up. Sandie, for making us food and bringing us much needed parts in her luggage, not to mention finding where I had put the parts at home! Lars and Sharayah for helping Sandie.

Jenna Kelly for being a great navigator and motivator during stressful times in the service park. Ben and Stewart (mechanics/service crew) Ben even though he admitted he knew little about cars, due to his high intelligence did everything asked of him and more, then did it well. Stewart for a 19 year old with no trade background is an awesome mechanic and there was no job I could not give him that was too hard for him to do and I was always confident I didn't have to check what he had done. Stewart put in a huge effort with me especially on the Wednesday before the event when Stewart and I didn't get to eat all day until 10:00pm, and if you know Stewart, missing food for 16 hours is a huge effort. This situation has been discussed at both Committee level and the November General Meeting. The proposal we are looking is that the magazine"" as such will be available on-line only.

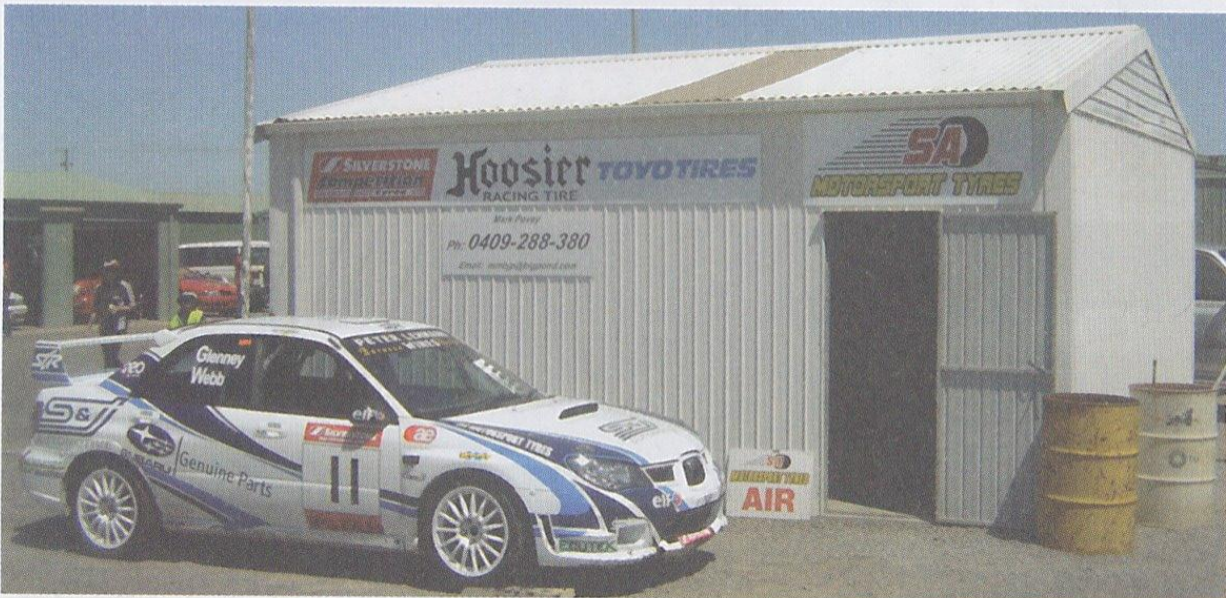

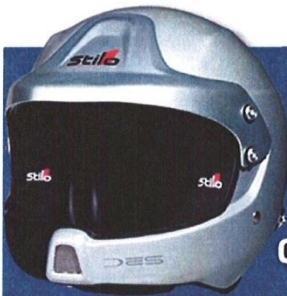

Michael Clements considered a number of organisations constitutions and found the simplest is from Australian Sports Commission.

## **Motion**

SDCC Constitution to have an addition to

### **Section 3 Membership part a)** to read

"No restrictions shall be imposed on any person by virtue of religious or political beliefs, sex race or age but the committee shall have the right to refuse membership and or renewal of membership to any person without assigning any reason therefore. A member may resign from the club by notifying the secretary in writing of the intention to do so and upon such resignation being accepted by the committee, he or she shall cease to be a member of the club."

### **3) MEMBERSHIP**
